

MSDN Dev/Test offer in the Enterprise Agreement (EA)*: As an Azure Enterprise Administrator, you can now enable Account Owners at your organization to create subscriptions based on the new [EA MSDN Dev/Test offer](#). You can do this by checking the box under the **MSDN** column for that Account Owner from within the [Enterprise Portal](#). In order for this to function correctly, please let the Account Owner know once you've made this change so that they can set up the EA MSDN Dev/Test subscriptions needed for your teams of MSDN subscribers. This new offer enables your active MSDN subscribers to run development and testing workloads on Azure at special dev/test rates, with access to the full gallery of MSDN images including Windows 8.1 and Windows 10.

To set up the Enterprise MSDN Dev/Test offer:

1. Log in as the enterprise administrator
2. Go to accounts → manage departments and accounts
3. Go to the account where you would like to enable dev/test MSDN access
4. Select the MSDN checkbox per column
5. EA MSDN subscriptions will be converted to the EA MSDN Dev/Test offer
 - Other subscription offer types, such as PAYG, associated with the account will be converted to Microsoft Azure Enterprise offers
